KAMAYAN ALSO KNOWN AS BOODLE FIGHT, IS A TRADITIONAL FILIPINO FEAST IN WHICH NO UTENSILS ARE USED. FOOD IS PREPARED AND ARRANGED ALONG BANANA LEAVES AS A COMMUNAL MEAL FOR A GROUP TO EAT ENTIRELY BY HAND. “KAMAYAN” MEANS “HANDS” IN TAGALOG.
