Nestled where the St. Lawrence River, Rideau Canal, and Lake Ontario meet, Kingston is one of Canada's oldest cities. A natural meeting point between Toronto and Montreal, the city and surrounding region offer historic landmarks and heritage architecture. Kingston boasts properties from the imposing Kingston Penitentiary, Canada's oldest maximum-security prison – built in 1834 and decommissioned in 2013 – to 21st-century high-rises; from Victorian lakeside mansions to time-worn motels and diners. In Kingston, filmmakers can travel through the decades – and the centuries – to find the perfect location.






A JOURNEY THROUGH ERAS





ELECTRICAL TIE-IN LOCATIONS
